- Publications can be ordered on Airservices Australia’s website. Training equipment can be purchased from pilot shops, e.g., Concept Aviation Supplies Pty Ltd at Bankstown Airport - www.conceptaviation.com.au - and www.downunderpilotshop.com.au, etc. Alternatively, let us know what you require, and we can order it in for you.
- PAC provides headsets to pilots and their passengers free of charge. However, many pilots feel more comfortable with their own. These can cost from \$250 upwards. David Clark headsets are the most popular and cost around \$400-\$500.
- You will need to undergo a medical examination by a Designated Aviation Medical Examiner (DAME). A DAME is a medical practitioner who specialises in aviation medicine. The Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) has a list of DAMEs for you to choose from. Go to their website www.casa.gov.au and click on “Aviation Medicals”.
