

NIGHT VFR RATING (NVFR)

You're happy to fly around the blue sky with perfect lighting conditions, but have you considered the challenge of flying at night?

Learning to fly under the VFR at night is a challenge that will hone your piloting skills. A NVFR rating is extremely rewarding whether you intend to regularly fly at night, or just want that knowledge up your sleeve incase you can't achieve your arrival time prior to last light. You will learn how to conduct all phases of flight at night, teaching you how to safely navigate even when many of your visual queues have disappeared into the dark.

If there was ever a more beautiful view than from above, it would be that same view with the ground lit up at night!

RATING REQUIREMENTS

- Hold a PPL, CPL or ATPL
- Minimum 10 hours experience, including at least 5 hours dual cross-country time (under NVFR)
- Pass NVFR Flight Test
